130gr/m2

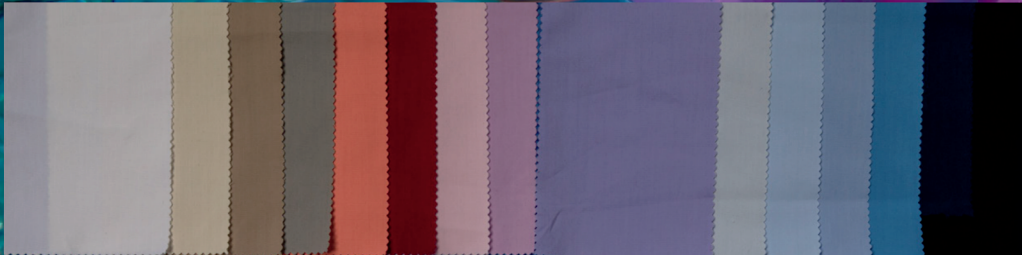
60° Washing

Recycled cotton made from pre-consumer cotton waste. Recycled polyester made from verifiable and traceable yarn made from recycled plastic bottles that could otherwise end up in landfill or the ocean.

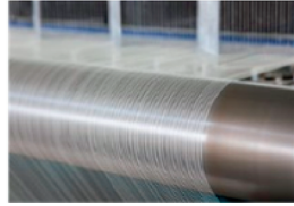
# RECYCLED COTTON

Recycled polyester is made from recycled materials [PET and polyester fabrics].

THE ENERGY NEEDED TO MAKE THE RPET IS LESS THAN WHAT IS NEEDED TO MAKE THE VIRGIN POLYESTER.

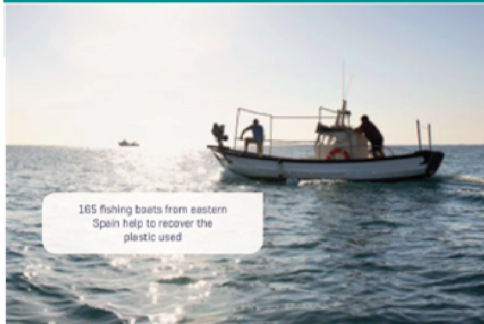
RECYCLING PET TO CREATE THE FABRICS PREVENTS IT FROM GOING TO LANDFILL.

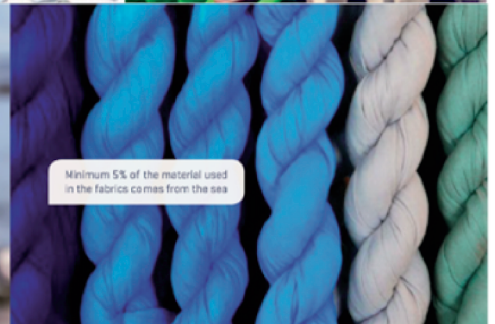

High standards in selecting the marine PET are among the keys to guaranteeing the final quality of the yarn.



Minimum 5% of the material used in the fabrics comes from the sea

With a vertical production process with controlled traceability, we recycle some of the plastic granules, yarn and fabric based on responsible manufacturing.

The result are recycled fabrics meeting all quality standards.

We turn plastic into polyester yarn to make fabrics

We make recycled polyester fabrics in a responsible, traceable, green production process
